REPORT OF EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR/ADMINISTRATOR

Town of Boonton COVID-19 Update: Amanda Bennett, the Town of Boonton's nurse participated in the Board meeting and gave us a report on how COVID-19 polices and procedures were being conducted and what input was needed or not needed from the BHA. A through detailed report was give for the status of anyone effected by the pandemic. A wealth of references and contact information was shared. The Town website is a go-to site for current and updated information for the Town of Boonton. www.townofboonton.org

- Zoom Meetings: Due to COVID-19 health emergency, Governor Murphy mandated that all group meetings will be cancelled until further notice. Effective March 27, 2020 all Board, staff and other related meeting will be held via ZOOM.
- Office Closing: Due to COVID-19 health emergency, the office will be closed to the public.

 The staff office time will be staggered to one-day a week and they will work from home the remaining of their hours. Access to the office will be set up through internet direct access to the office via their computers at home. BHA will be purchasing laptops for employees to work on at home.

Maintenance will only respond to emergency that are health or safety related. The BHA will issue plungers and masks to all residents living in the apartments to assist with minor plumbing issues.

Daily Operations of the BHA will be conducted by phone, email, fax and paper work drop off at the main office.

All public and housing choice voucher unit inspections will be conduct virtually via phone, iPhone skype, etc. iPad with a housing phone number will be purchased to conduct these inspections until further notice. Final hard copy inspections required to document the file will be due at a later date in accordance with the HUD approved waivers.

The community rooms and playgrounds will be closed until further notice.

The hot water heater in the laundry community room on Chestnut Street Cottages was replaced after 30 years.

Cottage #11 hot water heater was replaced and one extra hot water heater was put in storage.

Hot water boiler system contract proposals were due April 3, 2020. A Board resolution will be put forth at the next meeting for ratification.

- Evictions for non-payment of rent: On March 19, 2020 Governor Murphy enacted Moratorium on removals of individuals due to evictions for nonpayment of rent. The eviction process will be temporarily suspended until the pandemic is over and the Governor terminates the Ordinance. At this time no late fees or penalty fees can be charged to the tenants until July 2020.
- Financial Disclosures: Reminder to complete the Financial Disclosure forms sent to you by the Town of Boonton. They are due April 30, 2020.
- The Boonton Housing Authority will change it's All-lines insurance company effective May 1, 2020 to NJPHA-JIFF. We will be working with a Risk Manager who will act as a third-party contact for BHA and the Insurance Company. Their job will be to make sure the BHA remains in compliance and maintains decent, safe, and sanitary conditions and adequate coverage for all line items
- Debt Service: As the BHA progress through the Streamline Conversion Application process, one of the requirements is to pay off any outstanding Debt Service. This debt will be paid in full on March 31, 2020.

Capitol Funds Grant: The grant was approved for calendar year 2020 on April 3, 2020 in the amount of \$133,932.00.

2019 Annual Audit: Due to the COVID 19 pandemic, the independent annual audit due date for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019 has been moved to December 2020.

Subject: 2020 Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) Program Coordinator Funding

The Department is issuing this letter to encourage your agency to prepare for the upcoming Fiscal Year (FY) 2020 Family Self-Sufficiency Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) competition. Please review this letter carefully and share it with your FSS Program Coordinator(s), your Chief Financial Officer, and any other staff or individuals that work in the administration of your agency's FSS

program, including those involved in the process of preparing and submitting FSS applications through Grants.gov.

PIC Data/FSS Addendum:

Historically, HUD has used the number of FSS families in an applicant's FSS program to determine funding amounts for eligible applicants. The number of FSS participants has been based on Public and Indian Housing Information Center (PIC) data (which is obtained from PHA submission into the PIC system of information on the form HUD-50058 and HUD-50058-MTW). The number of FSS program participants shown in PIC includes enrollment, progress, and exit reports during the NOFA's target period (1/1/19 – 12/31/19). The PIC numbers have been made available as part of the NOFA for every eligible applicant. Prior to FY17, applicants were allowed to submit documentation to correct the numbers reflected in PIC if the numbers in the report published with the NOFA are incorrect and the correct number would result in more funding. Since the FY2017 FSS NOFA, HUD has relied on PIC exclusively and may continue to rely solely on PIC in future NOFAs.

In the past 3 fiscal years, HUD has provided a preliminary report that shows the number of FSS families in each eligible applicant's FSS program. This report covered the target period of past award cycles. The report counted all distinct FSS families (head of household) that had an enrollment, progress, or exit report during this period. The data in the preliminary reports were extracted from current and historical PIC records. For the FY2020 FSS NOFA, HUD will not be issuing a preliminary report. For NOFA purposes, HUD will use a report that will be pulled from PIC after July 10, 2020. To ensure that all potential applicants for the FY2020 FSS NOFA competition have the correct PIC information published in the NOFA report, each PHA must ensure that their their FY2019 FSS participation data is correctly reported in PIC before July 10, 2020. Remember, this is data from CY2019 that should have been reported to PIC within 60 days of the effective date.

Under the FY2020 FSS NOFA, HUD may rely solely on the numbers of FSS families in an applicant's FSS program that are reported in PIC and continue to allow only Moving to Work MTW PHAs and PHAs that serve RAD-Affected PBRA FSS participants to submit documentation to correct such numbers. To avoid any potential impact on their FSS funding in FY2020, PHAs should work diligently to ensure that the number of FSS

families is accurately reflected in PIC. Resources have been made available to assist PHAs in ensuring that PIC submissions are accurate.

Notice PIH 2016-08 (published on May 6, 2016) provides detailed guidance to non-MTW PHAs on PIC FSS reporting requirements. An eight-part webcast on the provisions of PIH 2016-08 (originally aired on August 12, 2016) is available in the webcast archives on HUD.gov. It can also be found here.

Please also see PIH Notice PIH-2010-25 - Timely Reporting Requirements of the Family Report (form HUD-50058 and form HUD- 50058 MTW) into the Public and Indian Housing Information Center

Also note that HUD established a set of warnings and fatal edits related to FSS PIC reporting. Please see Letter to PHAs on PIC system changes related to Section 17 "FSS Addendum" of form HUD-50058 (August 28, 2014)

Written Quotations

This process is used for contract and materials/services/equipment that are small purchases costing between \$2,625 and \$17,500. This process applies to procurement costing between \$2,625 and \$17,500 (annually). If it is unreasonable or impractical to procure through sealed bids, these purchases may be made by obtaining price or rate quotations from at least two sources (unless a QPA is used). Quotations must be in writing and should be solicited by two or more sources.

If purchase are for the site or maintenance area, adequate documentation must be made of the procurement and maintained by the Maintenance Supervisor (or AMP Manager) and provided to the Executive Director within seven (7) days of any procurement action. Copies of the procurement process and package should be provided attached to all invoices for payment and a duplicate package should be maintained by the Maintenance Supervisor and AMP manager (separately). The award shall be made in writing to the offeror providing the lowest acceptable quotation, unless justified in writing based on price and other specified factors, such as for architect-engineer contracts. If non-price factors are used, they shall be disclosed to all those solicited.






